

National Population and Housing Census – basic information

Until the end of September this year, the Statistics Poland (GUS) is conducting the **National Population and Housing Census** throughout Poland.

The censuses are carried out in accordance with the recommendations and standards of international organisations such as the EU and the UN, so that international comparisons could be made. It should be noted that the population of particular countries, as established based on relevant population censuses, is one of the factors taken into account for the allocation of EU subsidies or the number of seats in the European Parliament.

We would like to remind you that it is the duty of every person living in Poland to take part in the census. The census will last until 30 September this year.

Refusal to participate in the census may result in imposing a **fine** of up to PLN 5,000.

You can take part in the census:

- online on the website spis.gov.pl,
- by phone calling the census helpline at +48 (22) 279 99 99,
- at any city/town or municipal/commune office,
- with a census taker who may call you or come in person.

In Łódź, you can take part in the census in the following locations:
