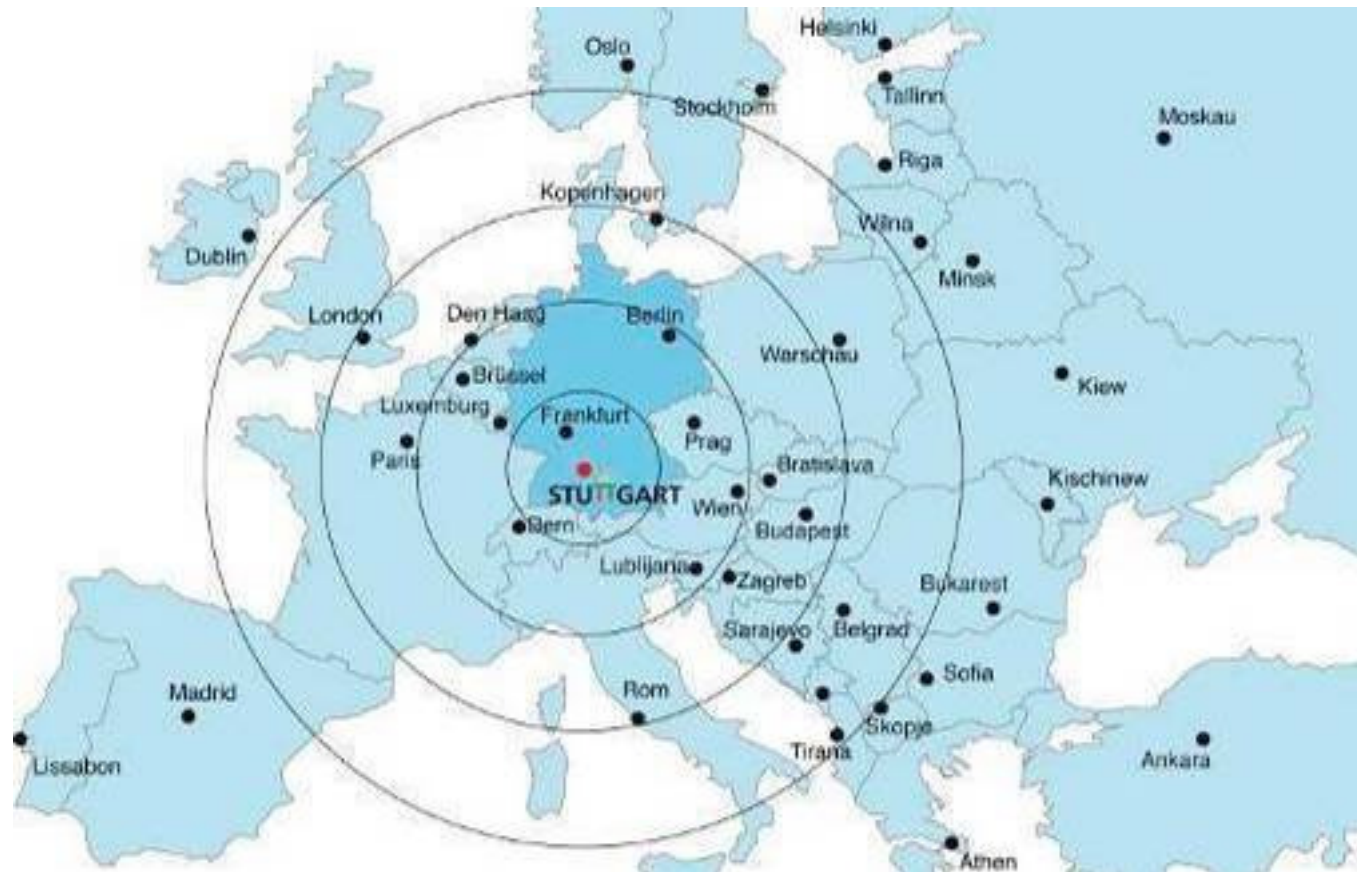


Schlossplatz in the centre of Stuttgart!

4 million people live in the economic powerhouse of Germany

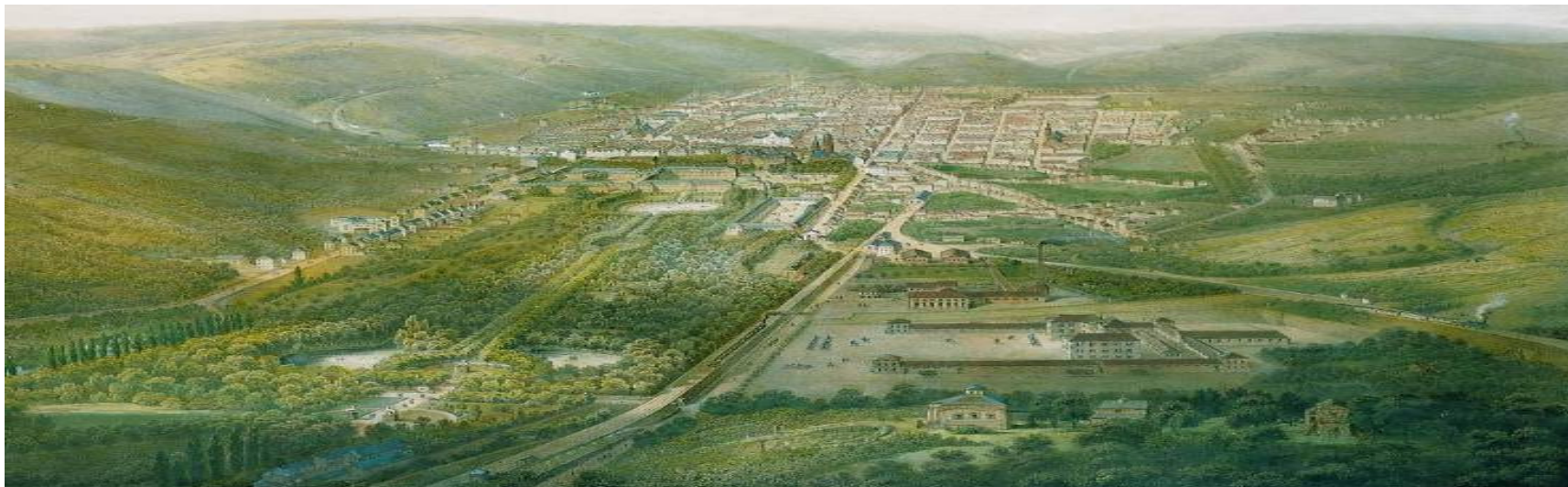




„Stutengarten“ - „stud“

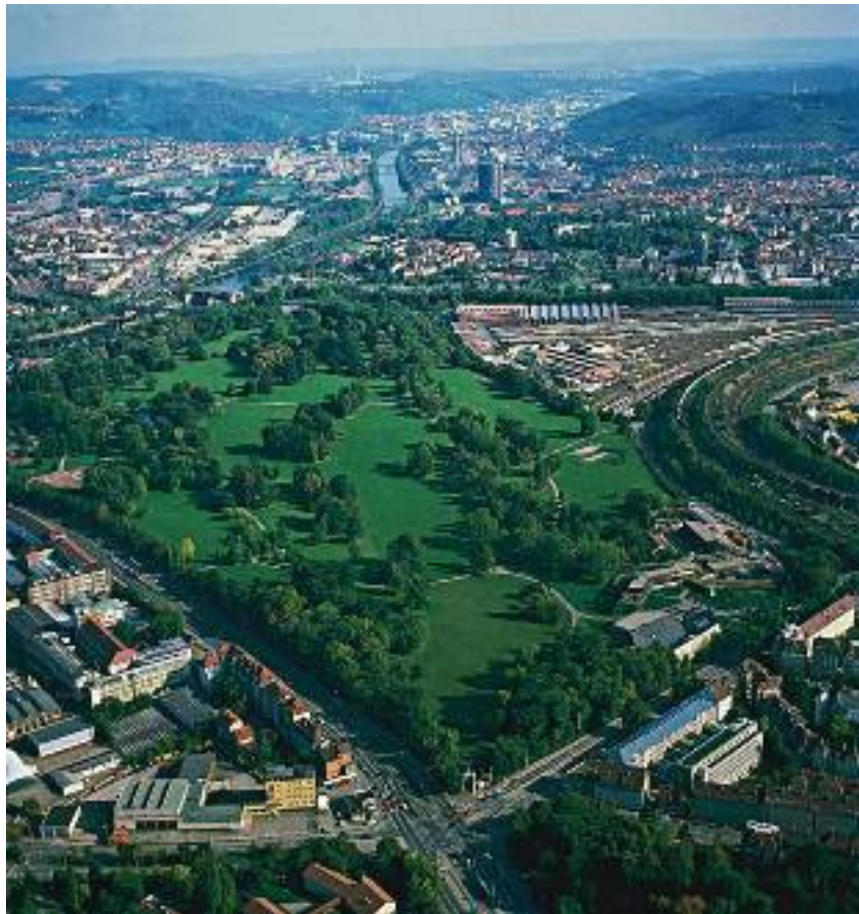
Stuttgart stands for *Quality of Life*



- one of the greenest metropolises in Europe
- forests and vineyards, parks and green spaces
- 39 % nature reserve and landscape conservation areas
- highest rate among all cities in Germany



Stuttgart stands for *Quality of Life*



- 50 % of the city territory are green spaces
- 100,000 trees in the city
- at a distance of 300 m maximum: public parks and recreational areas available for all
- a green corridor – 8 km long – right in the city centre

1. Economy

- Strategies to establish new Companies
- Promote Motivation and Willingness
- Promote Education
 - for example:
 - „Einstein in Kindergarten“
 - „Stuttgart Partnership for Education
 - Participation of Volunteers
 - Educational Mentors



2. Social Integration

- Childfriendly City
- All-Day Childcare Facilities
- „Pact for Integration“
- Partnership for Education for Immigrants
- „Stuttgart Generation Pact“



3. Urban Safety and Security

- Stuttgart – one of the safest major Cities in Germany
- Feeling of Safety is high
- Partnership for Safety and Security among
 - the Police Department
 - the Citizens of the City
 - the Town Hall

Crime Prevention includes all Spheres of Life



4. The Ecological Question

- Develop Alternatives to Nuclear Power
- Stuttgart Climate Protection Programme
- Energy Management in all Municipal Buildings
- Energy Advisory Centre
- “Triple Zero“
- E-Mobility
- Wind Turbines (share of 20 percent)



5. Internationality

- Stuttgart is a Immigration City
- Stuttgart is a City of Export
- Stuttgart has ten Twin Cities
- Lodz since 1988
- „Cities for Mobility“
- European Network „Cities for Local Integration Policies“ (CLIP)
- „Cities for Children“
- „Cities for Sports“
