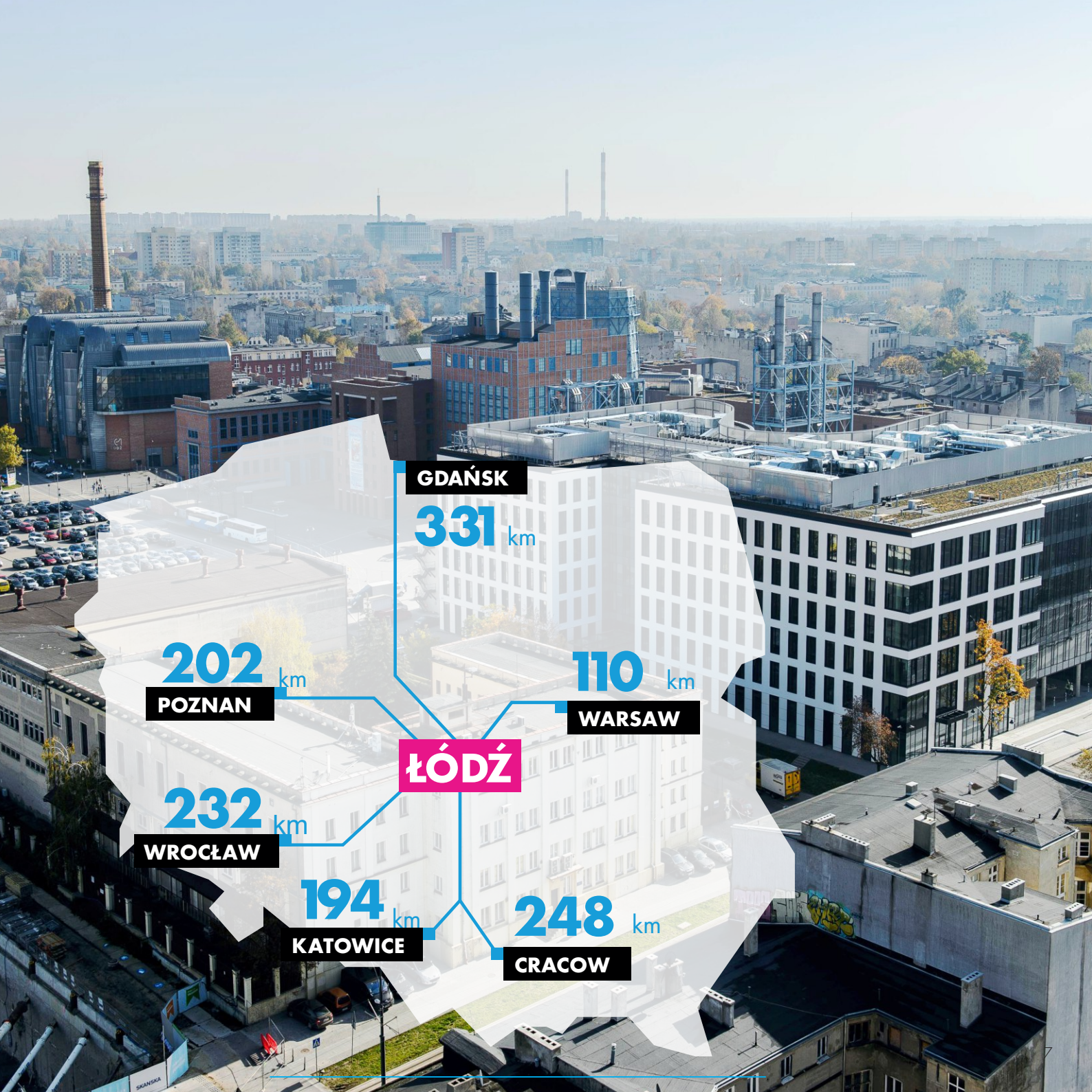

ALL ROADS LEAD TO ŁÓDŹ. LOCATION

One of the main advantages of Łódź is its central location. The city is located both in the central part of Poland and in the heart of Europe, making "everywhere is close by". Convenient location goes hand in hand with good communication - the agglomeration is surrounded by a network of motorways and expressways ensuring fast connections with Polish and foreign cities.

FAST LANE TO ŁÓDŹ. TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATION



Łódź Górna Road

ROADS

A short distance from Łódź is the junction of two major motorways: A1 and A2, which are part of the Trans-European Transport Network (TEN-T) connecting Western Europe with Eastern Europe and the Baltic countries with the southern part of the continent. The S8 expressway connecting Łódź with Wrocław, located south of the city, is also of international importance. The S14 expressway, which will complete the western section of the Łódź ring, is also under construction.

RAILWAYS

Łódź has good rail connections with all the major cities in Poland. For example, a trip to Warsaw takes just over an hour. The convenient connection with the capital is a major advantage determining the attractiveness of the city's office market.

Łódź offers a direct cargo railroad connection to Chengdu in China, which is part of the Belt and Road Initiative. The transit of goods from Poland to China over a distance of 10,000 km takes on average 12 to 14 days. By comparison, sea transport between Europe and Far Eastern ports takes about 45 days. Rail routes and terminals located in the central part of Poland therefore open up unique opportunities for Chinese companies interested in investing in Poland or in other European markets.

AIRPORTS

There are two international airports near Łódź. The Łódź Airport Central Poland is located approximately 10 minutes by car from the city centre, and handles passenger and cargo traffic. Whereas, 130 km away, in Warsaw, there is the largest airport in Poland - the Chopin Airport offering direct flights to over a hundred destinations around the world

DUOPOLIS: ŁÓDŹ – WARSAW

A distinctive feature of the city is its proximity to the capital city of Poland, stimulating business synergy between the two cities. The travelling time and communication between the cities is convenient enough to facilitate business and enables quick transport, and even daily commuting.

CHOPIN AIRPORT



It takes just 90 minutes to go from the centre of Łódź to the Warsaw Chopin Airport, from where you have easy access to a large number of national and international destinations.

CENTRAL TRANSPORT HUB (CPK)

About 100 km from Łódź the Central Transport Hub (CPK) is to be built. The future main transportation centre will combine air, rail, and road traffic. According to the project, the airport will serve 45 million passengers per year already after the first construction stage.

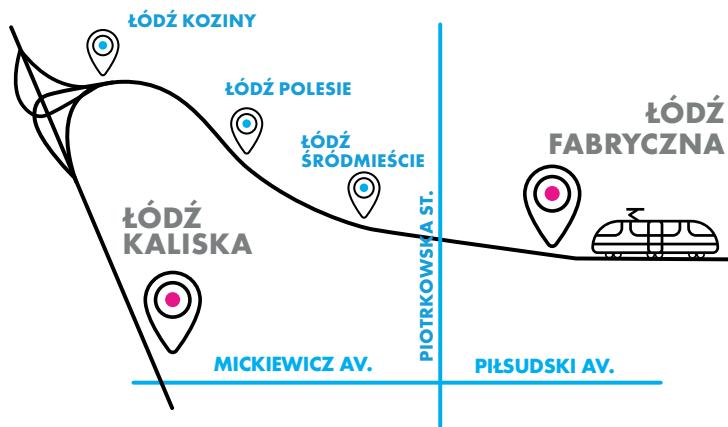
AND INSIDE THE CITY ITSELF...

In Łódź, there is a huge rail infrastructure investment in progress.

COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT

Due to the construction of a new cross-city tunnel under the Łódź Downtown, the tracks going through the centre of Łódź and the platforms were moved underground. These attractive areas will be released for new investment projects. Thanks to the tunnel, Łódź Fabryczna Railway Station will gain new connections, which will facilitate communication with other cities. There are also plans to build two additional underground stations. The new line going through the tunnel will be a sort of Łódź underground. The Łódź Fabryczna Railway Station is situated in the city centre and recently was completely renovated, becoming one of the most modern public transport interchange hubs in Europe.

YOUTH IN ŁÓDŹ. EDUCATION



Łódź is one of the major academic centres in Poland. The city offers 18 institutions of higher education, 7 public and 11 non-public, as well as 30 R&D institutions. There are almost 76 thousand people studying at the universities in Łódź each year, including 6 thousand foreign students, with ca. 20 thousand graduating each year.

THE UNIVERSITY OF ŁÓDŹ

is a young and creative university, and one of the largest higher education institutions in Poland, offering studies in humanities, social, natural, technical and economic sciences, with a total of 27 thousand students in its 12 departments. The university cooperates with a number of foreign higher education institutions and gives access to student exchange programmes. It is at the University of Łódź that the oldest School of Polish for Foreigners operates.

THE ŁÓDŹ UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

is one of the best technical universities in Poland, offering 51 fields of first-cycle and 41 of second-cycle studies at its 9 departments and at the International Faculty of Engineering. The University gives access to modern specialisations best tailored to the labour markets needs and to the development of scientific and technical science.

THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY

educates doctors, dentists, pharmacists and medical service specialists, and is the one and only university in Poland to provide studies for medical officers of the military healthcare service in cooperation with the Ministry of National Defence. The Medical University of Łódź is ranked one of the leading institutions, and its teaching, research, and lab facilities are among the best equipped in Poland.

THE ŁÓDŹ FILM SCHOOL

(LEON SCHILLER NATIONAL SCHOOL OF FILM, TELEVISION AND THEATRE)

is one of the oldest and the most prestigious film schools in the world. It educates directors, cameramen, actors, animation artists, editors, producers, script writers and photographers. It is the Alma Mater of many outstanding film-makers, with graduates including: Andrzej Wajda, Roman Polański, Kazimierz Kutz, Jerzy Skolimowski, Zbigniew Rybczyński, Krzysztof Kieślowski, Filip Bajon, and Janusz Gajos.

WŁADYSŁAW STRZEMIŃSKI ACADEMY OF FINE ARTS

is a modern artistic university for those who see their future professional career in art and design. The academy offers rich educational programmes, including such unique fields as fashion and jewellery design or use of theatre, film and television techniques.

GRAŻYNA AND KIEJSTUT BĄCEWICZ ACADEMY OF MUSIC IN ŁÓDŹ

is one of the leading art academies in Poland. It is open to new forms of developing passion and talent as well as promoting musical culture and education. Its rich didactic offer comprises over 50 specialisations in four departments.

ŁÓDŹ SPEAKS DIFFERENT LANGUAGES

Foreign languages constitute an important element of the education in Łódź-based schools and universities. All students attend mandatory language courses. Even if it is English that is the most common choice, the students often choose another foreign language, such as German, French, Russian, Spanish and Italian.

Linguistic fields of studies aimed at improving foreign languages skills, key in today's labour market, are also very popular and are selected by above 3 thousand young people every year.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE SKILLS

About 30 private language schools give the opportunity to learn more (English, German, Russian, French, Spanish, Italian) and less popular foreign languages (such as Scandinavian or Asian languages).

The foreigners may benefit from a wide offer of the Polish language courses, with the School of Polish for Foreigners (at the University of Łódź), the oldest institution of this kind, as the most recognised one.

EDUCATION IN ŁÓDŹ

Łódź also has a well-developed educational base. The city has over 200 kindergartens, including multilingual kindergartens, as well as numerous primary and secondary schools, including schools with specialised classes which prepare pupils for passing the final exams in foreign languages. This makes the possible relocation of employees and their families much easier.

Łódź gives the opportunity to learn in the British International School - the only institution in central Poland which provides education based on the British English National Curriculum to children and teenagers from 2.5 to 18 years of age.



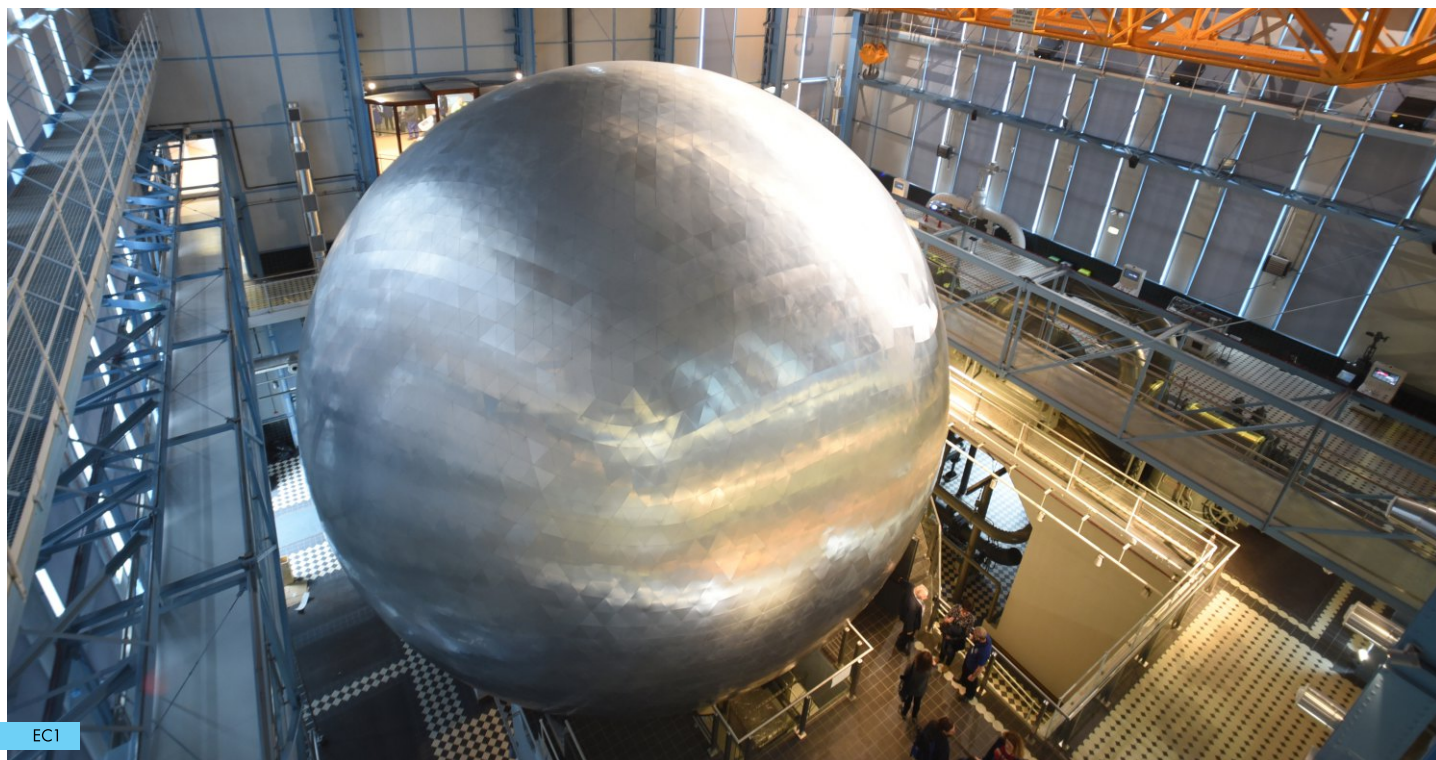

THE NEW CENTRE OF ŁÓDŹ

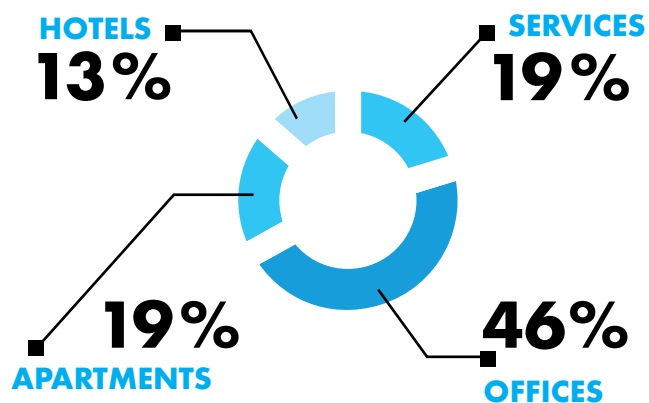


The New Centre of Łódź (NCŁ) is a modern space in the very heart of the city which combines business, cultural, commercial and transport functions. Thanks to the ongoing works, almost the 100 ha area in the centre of Łódź is being extensively revitalised. The NCŁ area includes, among others, the EC1 building, the new underground Łódź Fabryczna Railway Station and modern office buildings.

Within NCŁ you will find, for example, the revitalised building of the first power station in Łódź - EC1. The unique character of the place refers to the industrial past of the city. Currently, EC1 has cultural, artistic and educational functions. It hosts, in particular, the largest Science and Technology Centre in Poland and the most modern planetarium. The EC1 complex is also the seat of institutions associating artists and filmmakers - the Łódź Film Commission and the Centre for Comics and Interactive Narration.

An important landmark in the New Centre of Łódź is the new underground Łódź Fabryczna Railway Station, which will become part of a multimodal transport hub, combining railroads, long-distance buses, cars and public transport. The investment also involves the reconstruction of the road system around the station, which will give Łódź a chance to become one of the best communicated cities in the country.

EXPERIENCE OF ŁÓDŹ. QUALITY OF LIFE IN THE CITY

Łódź is the capital of creative industry, clubbing, artistic events and festivals. The nineteenth-century traditions of an industrial and multicultural city are main-tained and result in ongoing development. The landscape of Łódź includes eclectic palaces of factory owners, large-format murals, the experience of four cultures, factory halls and chimneys, as well as the vibrant Piotrkowska Street, one of the longest streets in Europe, which is the centre of cultural and film events.

CULTURE

Situated in the heart of Poland, the city hides many secrets and offers a wealth of attractions, including:

NEW CENTRE OF ŁÓDŹ / OFF PIOTRKOWSKA / MANUFAKTURA / KSIĘŻY MŁYN

PIOTRKOWSKA STREET. One of the longest shopping streets in Europe. There are tenement houses, palaces and villas of factory owners, churches, monuments of famous Łódź citizens, and the headquarters of cultural institutions and creative industries.

THE POZNAŃSKI PALACE. The Eclectic palace of Izrael Poznanski is the largest residence of factory owners in Poland.

MUSEUM OF CANAL "DĘTKA". Hidden under Liberty Square, it is a fragment of the 19th century underground sewage system.

MURALS IN ŁÓDŹ. Large format paintings that have already grown into the city landscape and changed the face of Łódź.

MUSEUM OF CINEMATOGRAPHY. It presents impressive collections related to the history of cinematography. In the museum there is one of the six existing in the world photoplasticon built around 1900.

VILLAS AND PALACES. There are about 200 villas and palaces of factory owners in the city.

POST-INDUSTRIALISM. There are about 300 post-industrial buildings in Łódź.

SPORT AND RECREATION

AQUAPARK "FALA". A water park with a number of swimming pools, including one with an artificial wave, and a slide called "Kamikaze" (the highest in Poland), and relaxation zone as well.

ATLAS ARENA. One of the largest sports and entertainment halls in Poland, where excellent volleyball and basketball events and shows are held.

THREE CITY STADIUMS. There are two football stadiums and one speedway stadium in the city.

ŁAGIEWNICKI FOREST. Łagiewnicki Forest is one of the largest forests within the city boundaries in Europe.

PARK NA ZDROWIU. Park Na Zdrowiu with a botanical garden and the Orientarium that is currently under construction.
